Adhesive 1989 with hardener 1993 is used for the gluing of wood to wood. It gives glue joints with a very high strength in various environments. The bond has a high degree of heat, creep and solvent resistance. The system passes CWS and cycle test on hardwood.

1989 with hardener 1993 can be used in both cold and hot pressing as well as in RF-pressing.

Can be processed further after 2-6 hours, but best result is achieved if samples are left 24 hours. The full moisture resistance will be reached after approximately 14 days.

### Handling and Environmental Information

#### Handling

Avoid direct contact with the products. Always wear protective gloves and protective goggles.

Good working hygiene should be observed. The hardener contains isocyanate, which reacts with the moisture of the skin.Use gloves suitable for handling isocyanates (preferably nitrile). Always use goggles when handling the product.

Do not allow the hardener to come in contact with water or moisture.

#### Cleaning

For cleaning of equipment and tools, use lukewarm water. Addition of cleaning agent 4450 or 2704 will facilitate the cleaning.

Cleaning must start before the system cures. Cured adhesive must be removed mechanically.

Only use dry tools for mechanical cleaning of isocyanate containing products.

#### Waste Handling

Adhesive: For waste handling, please refer to section 13 in the SDS.

Hardener: Contains isocyanates and shall be treated as hazardous waste.

Adhesive/hardener mixture: Can normally be treated as non-hazardous waste when fully cured.

Leave residues to cool down and dry or cure before sending it off for disposal.

#### Waste Water Treatment
